How to setup user accounts on iNet Guardian


In order to monitor user activity on the Internet you will need to create user accounts. To create the accounts you will need to login into your iNet Guardian account.

Once you have logged in click on the **Users** menu option and click on **Add Via Wizard** button

and you will be presented with the Add New User Wizard

Type in a user name and click on **Next**.

It is recommended that you use a username will allow you to easily view the device in the dashboard, for instance Pauls iPhone or Pauls iPad.

If you have another user already created that you want to copy the user settings from tick the **Copy from another client** box and then choose which user to copy the settings from and click on **Next** and this will take you back to Manage Users.

A main list of the categories of sites are shown on the left hand side, Adult Content, Entertainment etc. Select one of the main list of categories to see all the individual categories that can be set. These can be set to **Monitor**, **Allow** or **Block**.

These have been set appropriately by default for the relevant age range.

If you want to manually add a site to be blocked then scroll to the bottom of the screen click in the text box below **Blocks** and type the site name(s) to be blocked.

If you want to bypass a site and thereby allow a user to access it then scroll to the bottom of the screen click in the text box below **Bypass** and type the site name(s) to be bypassed.

The example below shows a website that you want to allow entered into the Bypass box (*.allowthis.com) and a site you want to block added into the Blocks box (*.blockthis.com). Please ensure that the entry starts with * so for instance to allow www.disney.com you would need to enter *.disney.com into the Bypass box.

Select what (if any) search engines you want to block by selecting the block button next to the name of the search engine. A list of child friendly search engines appear at the top of the list.

PLEASE NOTE – Some safe search engines use Google so if you disable Google but allow the Safe Search Engine then the Safe Search Engine will not work as it relies on access to Google.

Click on **Next**

Access Usage Times

There are two settings on this tab, **Time Allowance** and **Usage Schedule**.

The **Time Allowance** allows you to set the amount of time that the device can access the Internet in a particular day, this can be set to hours and minutes.

Usage Schedule sets what times of the day the device is allowed to access the Internet. Just click into a box to turn it red, which means that Internet access is not allowed. Blank means that Internet access is allowed.

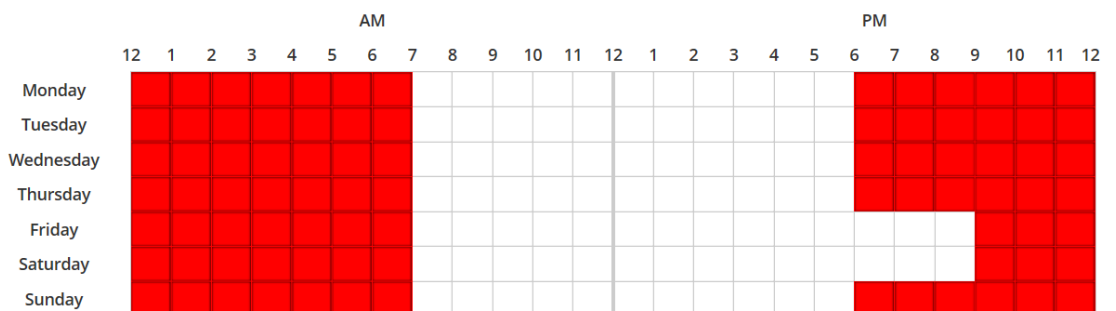
Use the controls below to set a daily time allowance for your child's devices. Once your child reaches their daily quota, access will be restricted as specified in "Device lock type" until the next day. To fully restrict access for one day set the time allowance to zero, to fully allow - 24

Choose to Enable Anti-Phishing Filter

The Anti-Phishing filter will compare the website being accessed against known Phishing sites. Phishing sites are sites which appear to be legitimate, such as a financial institutions or online payment systems such as Paypal, but are actually accurate copies of the real websites to fool you into entering authentication information which can be used to gain fraudulent access to your bank/financial institution.

Select if you want iNet Guardian to block any Phishing sites, which are sites created to look like valid sites (such as financial institutions) but are fake and are used to capture user names and passwords to allow these to be used by criminals for fraudulent purposes. The site being accessed is compared to a list of known Phishing sites and, if required, automatically blocked.

If you want to be notified of changes to the user account such as adding web sites to a block list then enter an email address and the frequency that you want the emails sent.

Tick the Notify admin tick box and click on **Create User**.

Click on **Create user** and you will get a message that the user has been created, and if you click on the **Users** menu option the user will be created and listed as a user.
