

## Removing iNet Guardian from Android

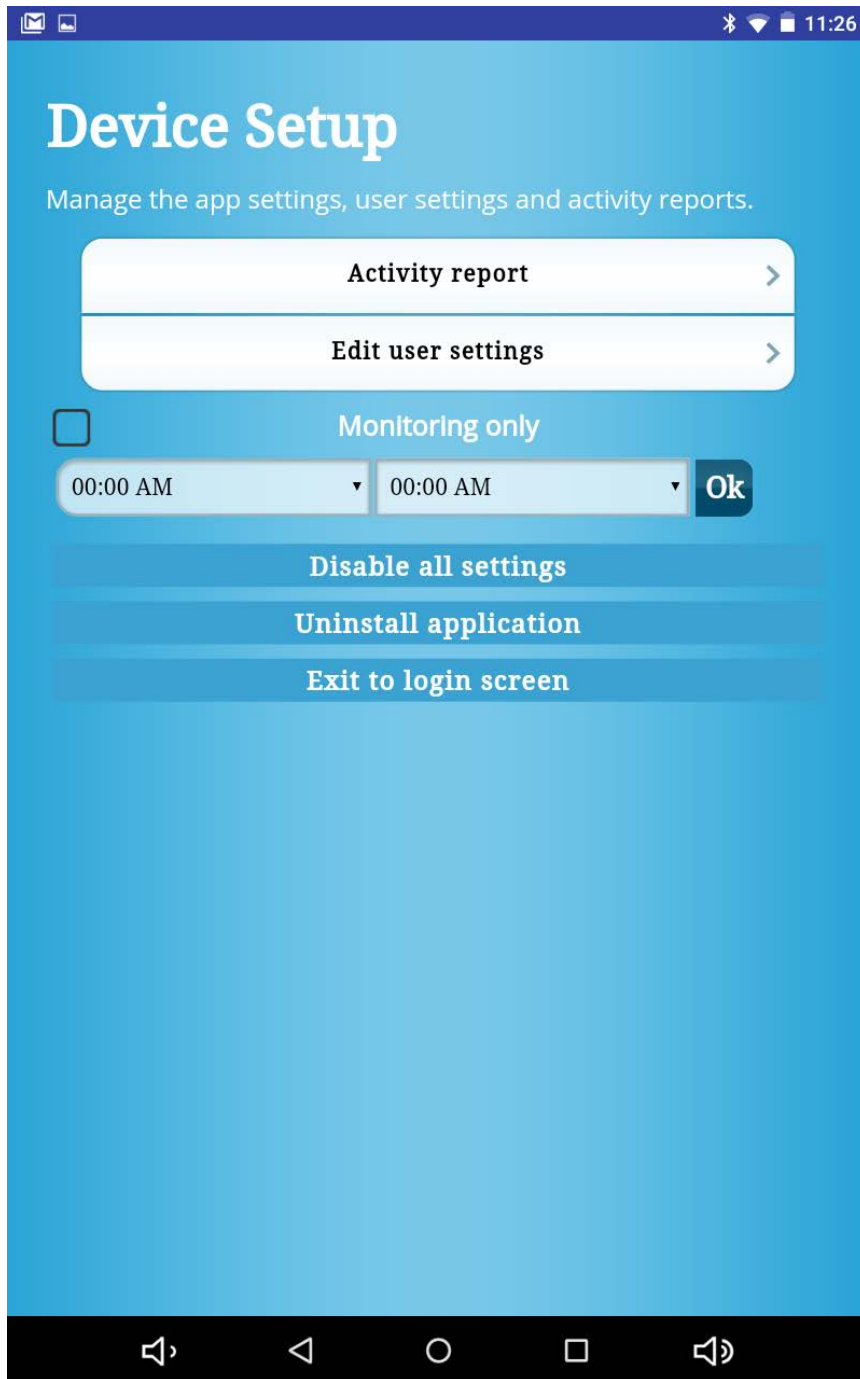
In order to remove iNet Guardian on an Android device you will need to login to iNet Guardian on the device you want to remove it from.

Enter your email/username and password and click on **Login**

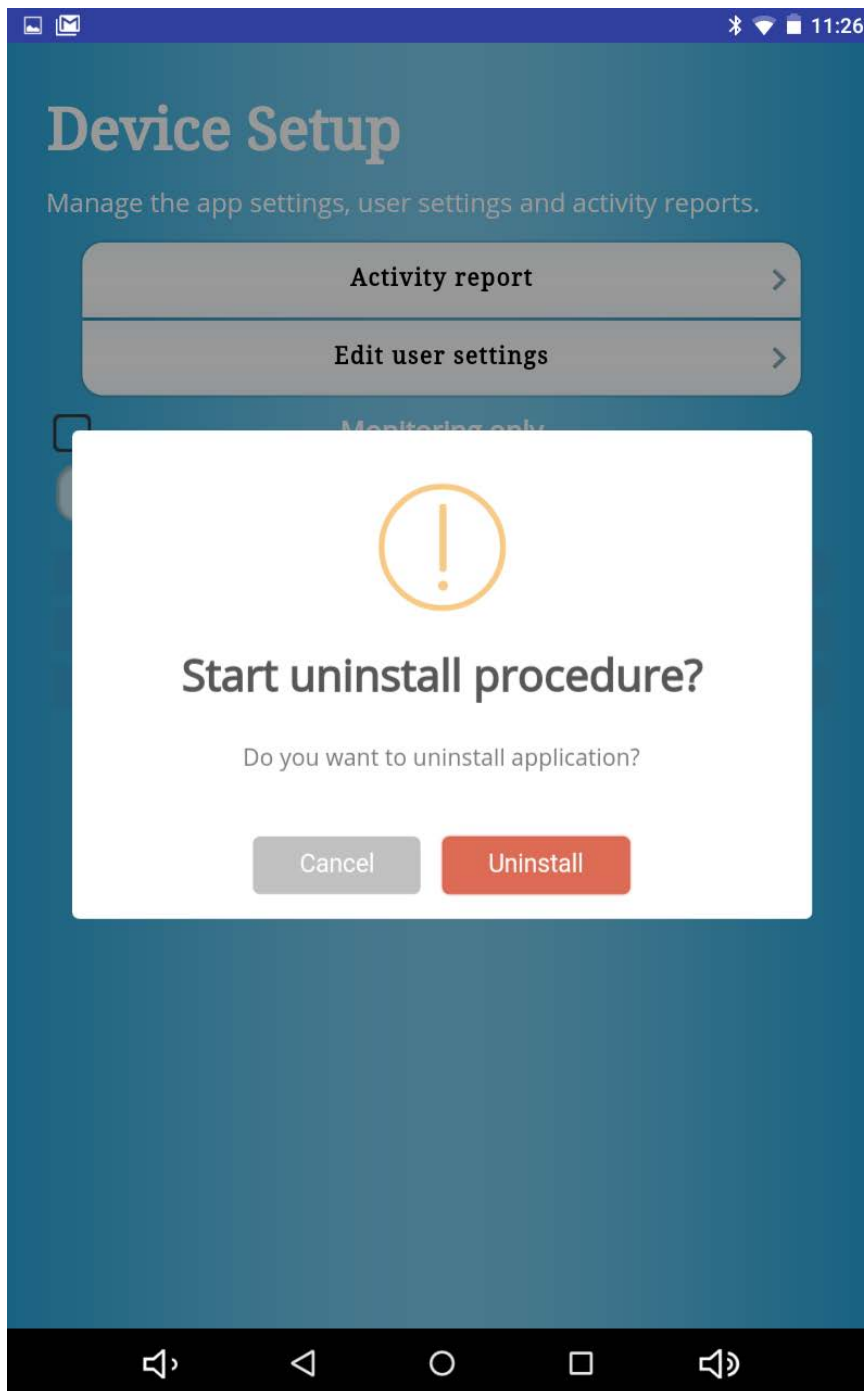

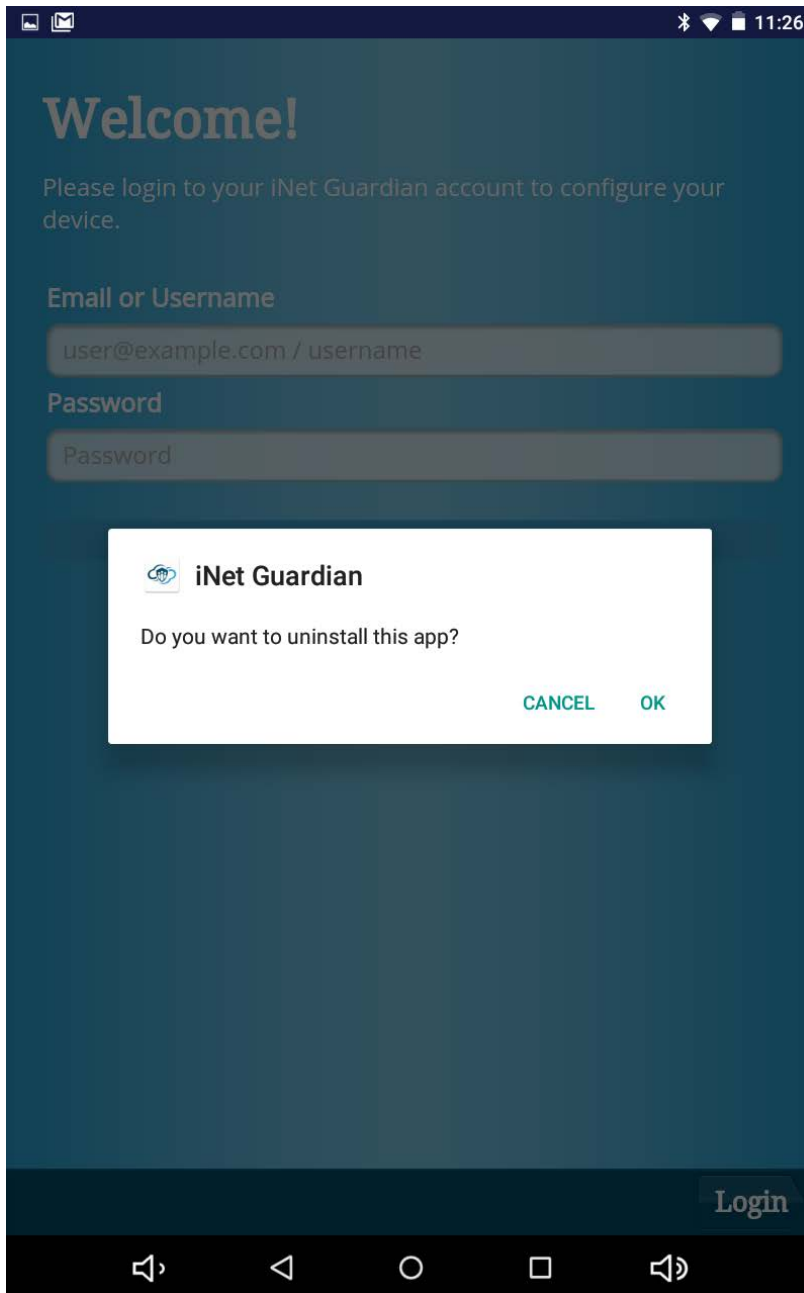
Once you have logged into iNet Guardian you can select **Uninstall Application**.



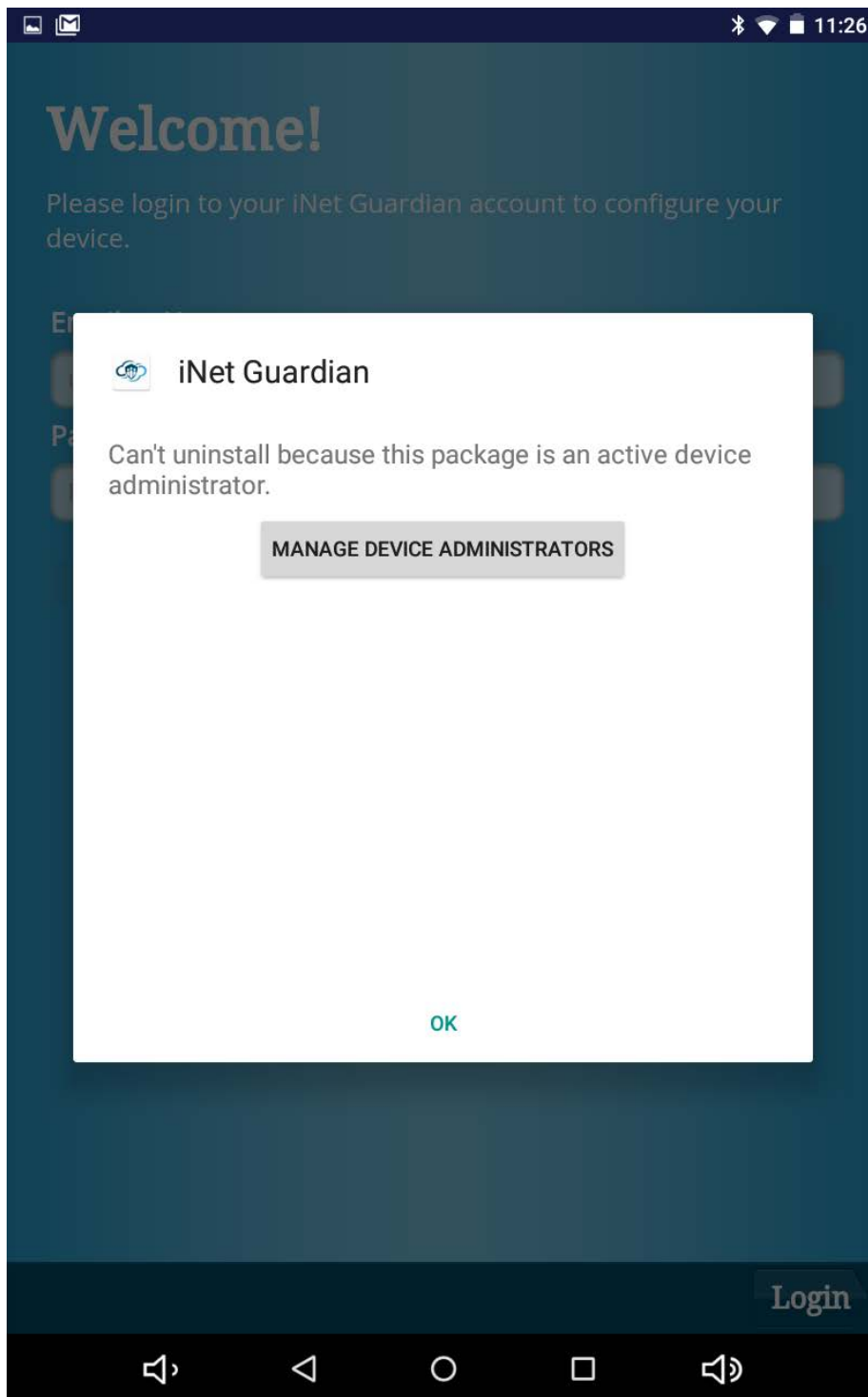
A message saying "Start uninstall procedure?" will be displayed and click on **Uninstall**.



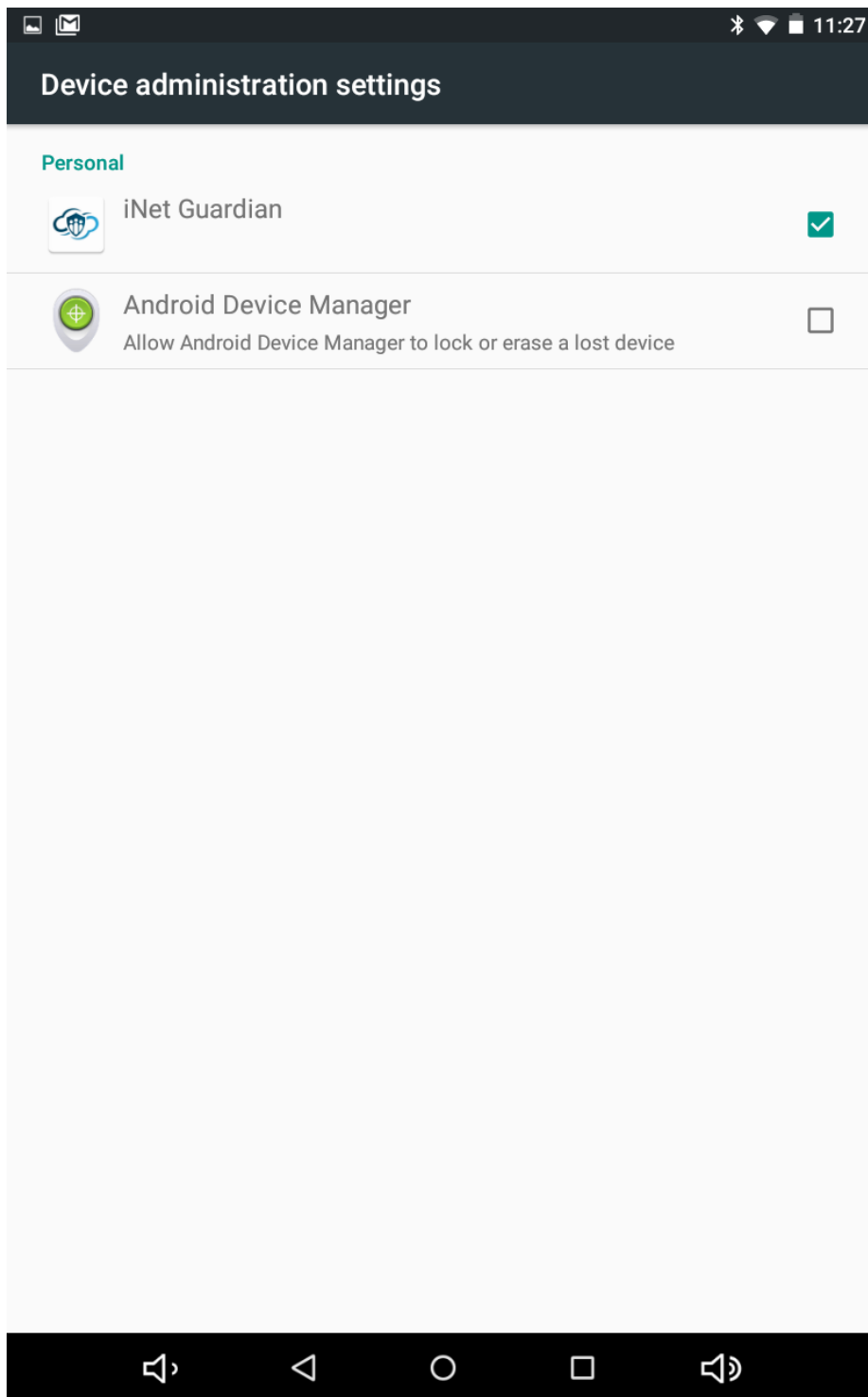
You will be asked if you want to uninstall the app. Click on **OK**.



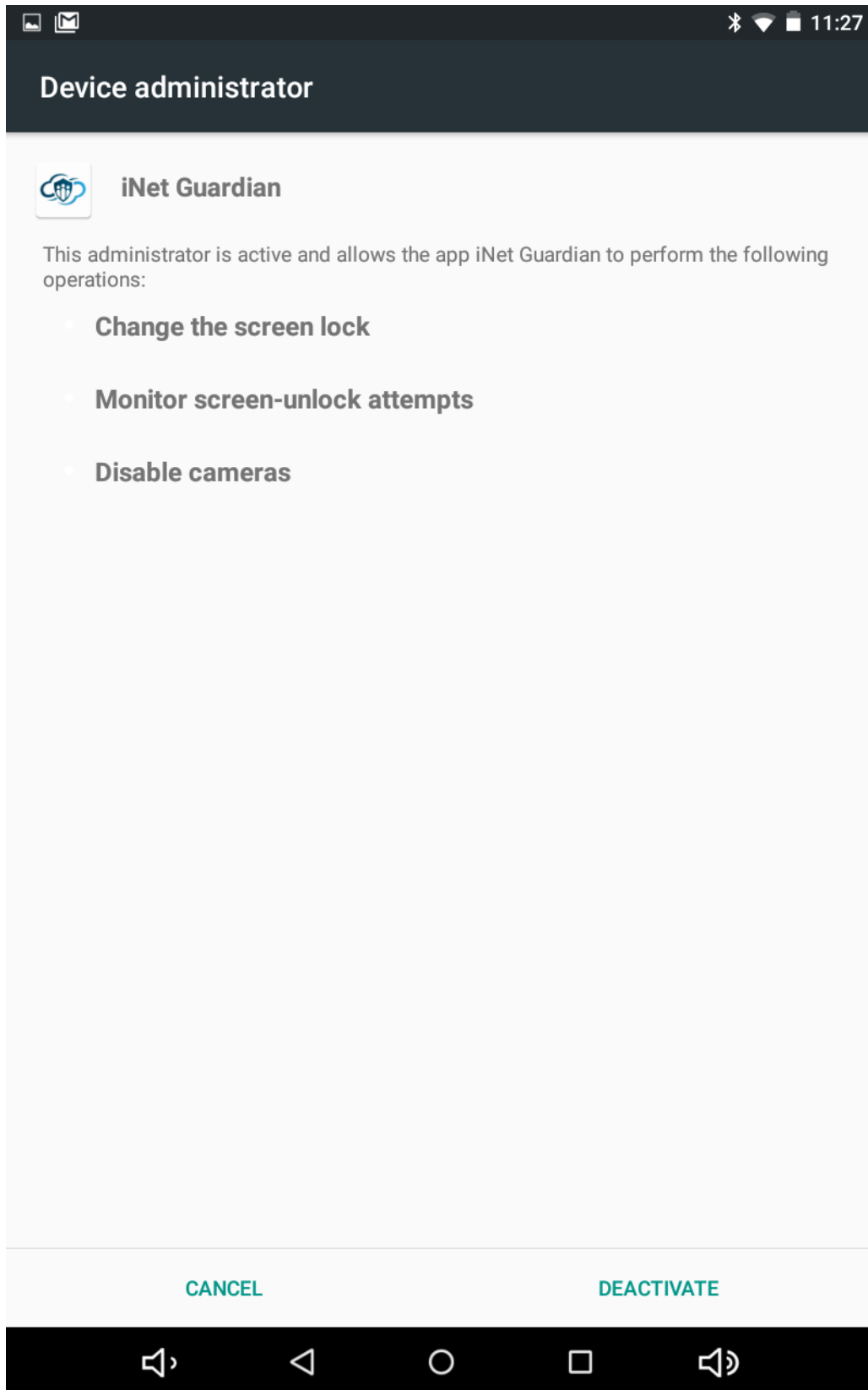
A message will be displayed saying that the package can't install because it's an active device administrator. Click on **Manage Device Administrators**
