

Removing iNet Guardian from iOS

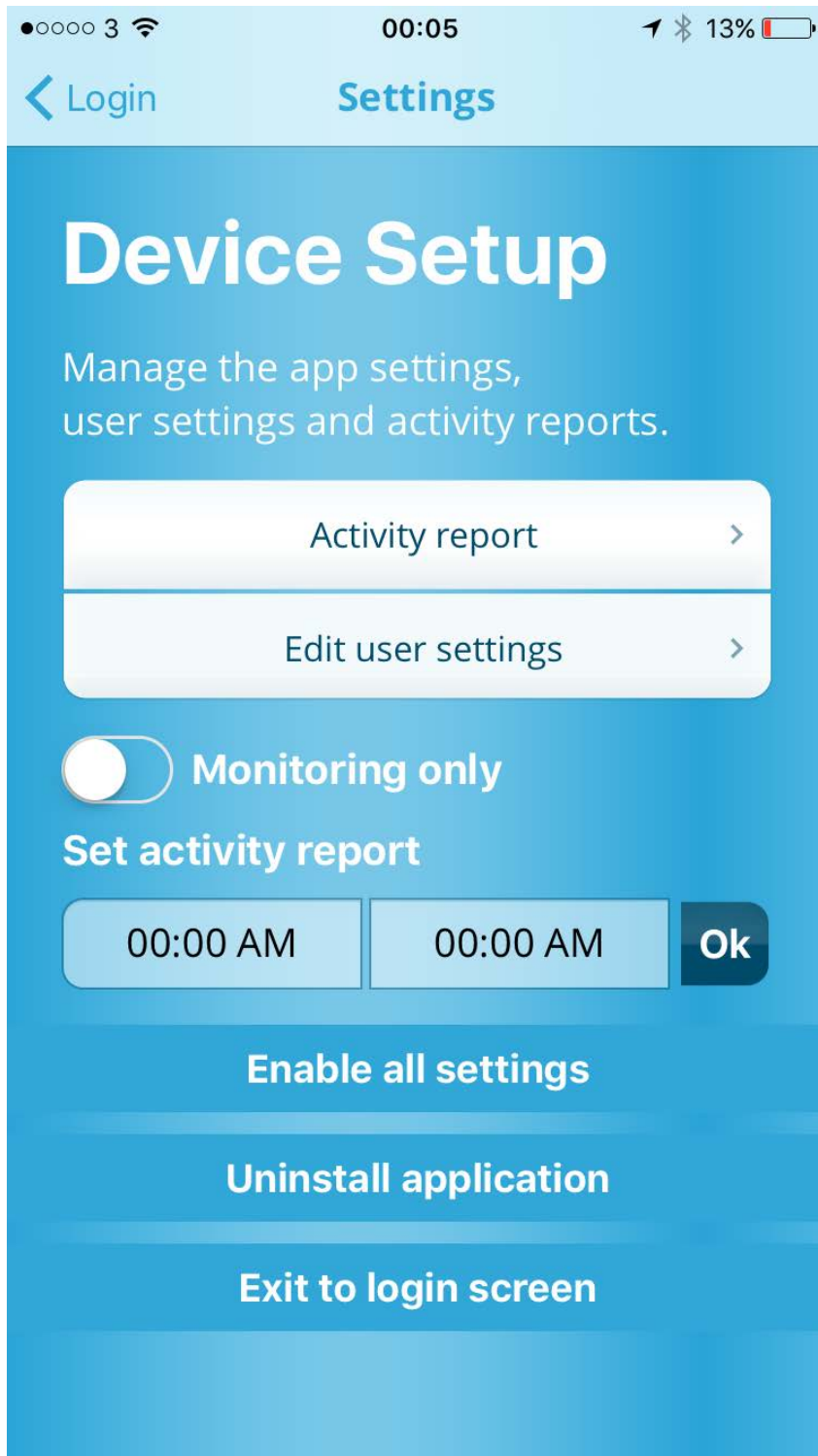
In order to remove iNet Guardian on an iOS device you will need to login to iNet Guardian on the device you want to remove it from.

Enter your email/username and password and click on **Login**

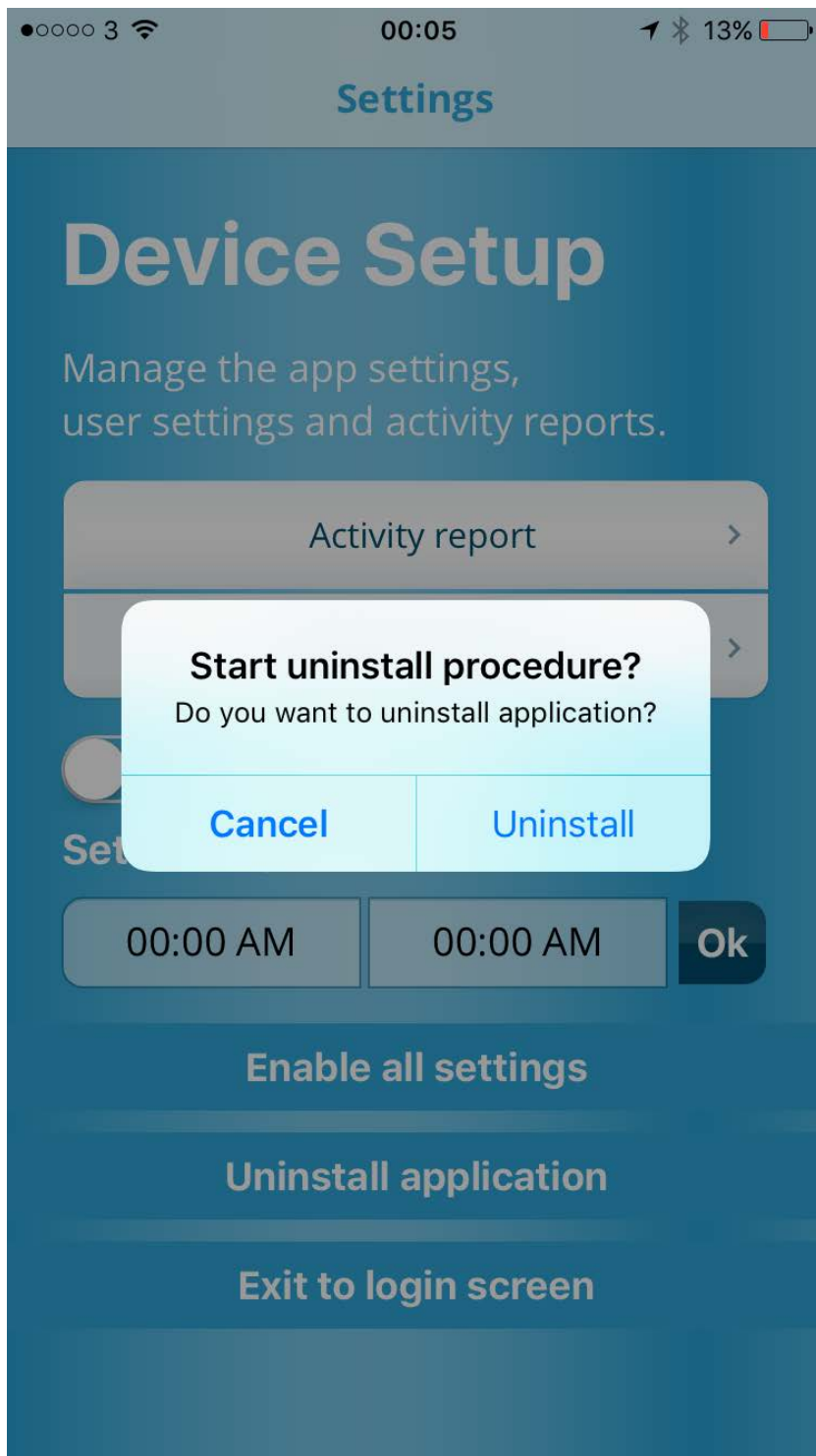

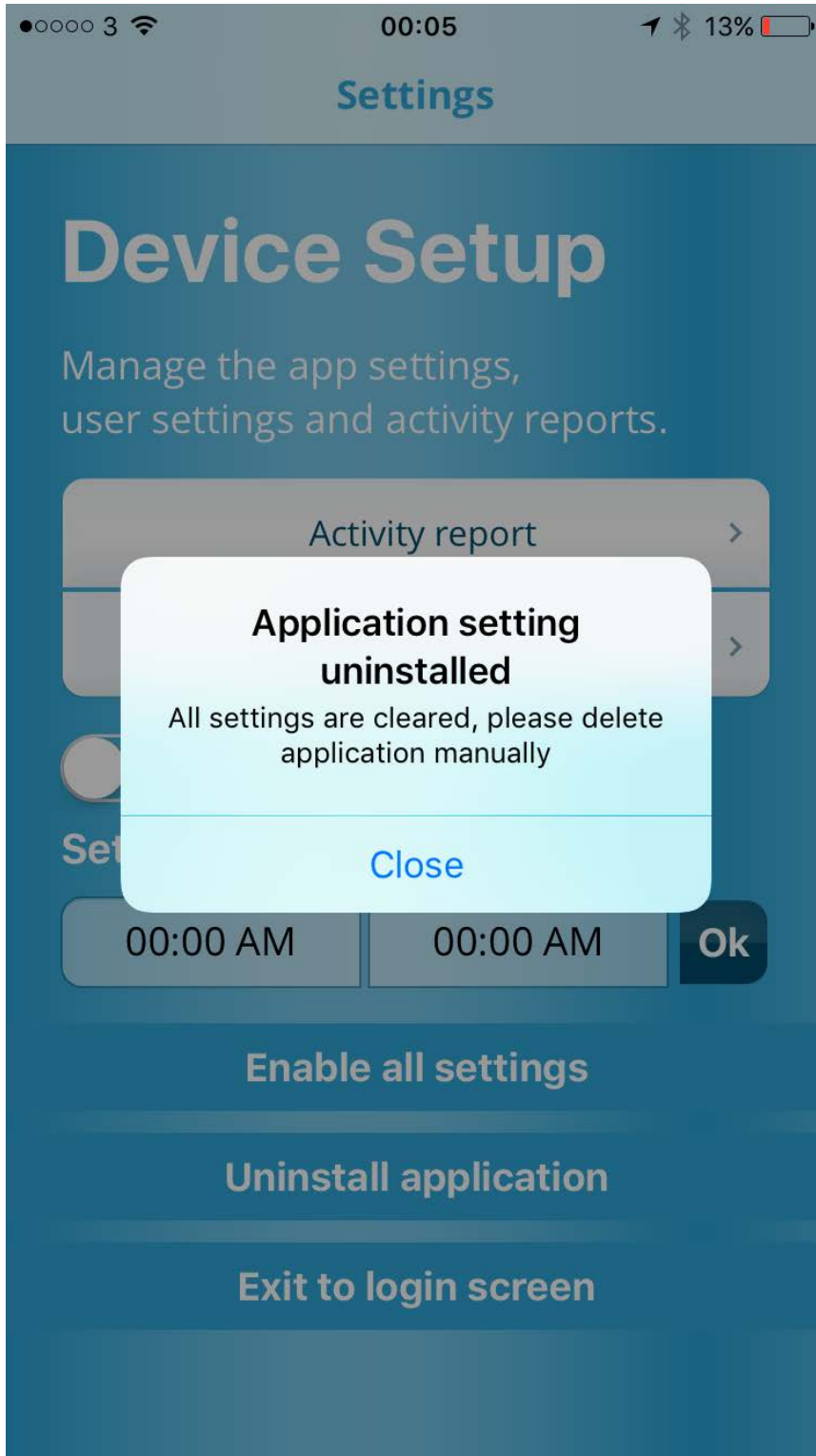
Once you have logged into iNet Guardian you can select **Uninstall Application**.



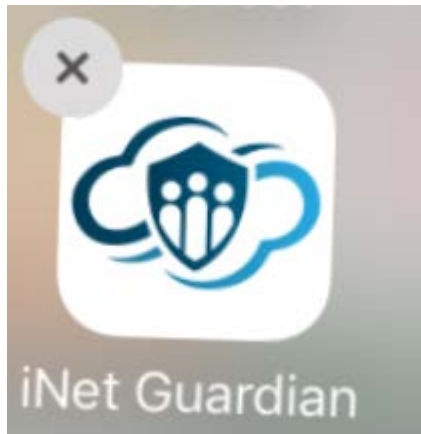
A message saying "Start uninstall procedure?" will be displayed and click on **Uninstall**.

From the main screen, look for the iNet Guardian application and then hold your finger onto the application until an “X” appears on the icon as shown. The “X” will appear on all icons and they will all move from side to side.



Click on the “X” to remove the application and click the **Home** button  and see if the iNet Guardian app has been removed.

Test your internet browsing to ensure that it is working correctly.
